

THE CONFERENCE

The **International Conference on Polyolefin Characterization** was born with the need of an international conference specifically focused on Polyolefin Characterization. It is organized through a small group of researchers from the academia and the industry with the goal of the exchange of the most innovative developments on polyolefin characterization to improve the understanding and knowledge in this field.

ICPC Conference covers different aspects of the characterization of Polyolefin molecular architecture, including molar mass distribution, comonomer incorporation and distribution, long chain branching, crystallinity and rheological properties. The **technical program** includes:

- Polyolefin Separation and Fractionation.
- Spectroscopy.
- Thermal Analysis.
- Rheology.
- High throughput screening techniques.

The Conference, held every two years, is intended for all researchers, rather new or experienced, in the polyolefins industry and academia. It is an excellent opportunity to discuss the latest developments in Polyolefins Characterization.

First edition of ICPC was held in Houston in **2006** attendance was higher than 100 attendees from 18 countries around the globe including important petrochemical companies like Dow Chemical, ExxonMobil, Basell, DSM, Borealis, Total, Formosa Plastics, SamsungTotal, Chevron-Phillips or Nova Chemical; Vendors and Universities and Research Institutes like Univ. of Waterloo, German Inst. For Polymers, Max-Plank Inst., Univ. Ohio, Univ. Florida, Univ. Cath. Leuven, Japan Advanced Inst. of Science and Technology (JAIST)... Technical Program consisted of more than 60 contributed papers including oral and poster sessions. Major sponsor of the first edition Houston 2006 was Dow Chemical, which was recognized with the logo in the Conference web page, in the Conference Book and circulars, in the advertising posters and as the one and only supporter of the Poster session Cocktail. Other contributed sponsors were ExxonMobil Chemical, Polymer Laboratories, Waters, Viscotek, PSS, Viscotek or Polymer Char, which were recognized with the logo included in the website, advertising posters, and conference proceedings.

Second edition of ICPC Conference was held in **2008** in Valencia (Spain), with more than 120 attendees from 24 countries and more than 70 contributed papers in the Technical Program, again consisting of oral and poster presentations. Most of the companies present in the first edition attended again this second ICPC in Valencia, as well as Sinopec, Sabic, Polimeri Europa, Repsol, Arkema Group and others... Thus, in the 2008 edition ICPC conference was consolidated as the worldwide reference meeting dedicated to polyolefin characterization. It was strongly supported by Borealis, The Dow Chemical Company and LyondellBasell. Other important petrochemical companies and instrumentation vendors contributed also; ExxonMobil, The Dutch Polymer Institute, Agilent Technologies, Polymer Laboratories, Polymer Char, Anton Paar and Progression Inc.

The **3rd edition of ICPC Conference** will be held in **Shanghai, China on November 8-10, 2010**.
